Produced by Humber Galleries and led by Humber Bachelor of Music alumnus Mason Victoria, Student Fellows will together develop an artistic project, presenting their completed multi-disciplinary work as part of Nuit Blanche on October 2, 2021.

Students accepted into the program will work part time, 24 hours a week from May to August, 2021, each earning \$6,000.

- Preference will be given to students in third or final year of a Degree OR second or final year of an Advanced Diploma OR final year of a Diploma or completing a Graduate Certificate
