



REACTIVATION is back for another round after the amazing feedback and participation from our Spring iteration. This project brings together a group of multi-disciplinary Humber students to explore how disciplines can inspire creation in one another while working completely separated.

HOW IT WORKS

"REACTIVATION" begins with reactivating our Permanent Art Collection by activating student collaboration. Taking a handful of collection artworks, we have tasked a small group of student creatives to create musical works in direct reaction to these artworks; Focusing in on their initial reaction and creating work based directly on that inspiration. From there these musical pieces will be given to a second group of students to react in the same way, only this time in the form of Animation or Digital Artworks. This process then repeats for other a final group of students to create works in any Creative Writing field.

PROJECT PHASES

Phase 1 – Music/Soundscapes (takes place Oct 4 - 22)

In reaction to artworks from the Humber Galleries Permanent Art Collection students in this phase are tasked with creating an audio work of their choosing. These works could take the form of a song, instrumental, soundscape, any format that is musical in nature.

Phase 2 – Animation/Digital Art Pieces (takes place Oct 25 - Nov 12)

In reaction to the audio works created in Phase 1, students in this phase are tasked with creating animation or digital art pieces of their choosing. These works can take the form of a digital painting, 3d landscape, particle rendering, any format that is digital in nature.

Phase 3 – Creative Writing (takes place Nov 15 - Dec 3)

In reaction to the movement pieces created in Phase 2, students in this phase are tasked with creating a creative writing piece of their choosing. These can take the form of poetry, short story, prose, any creative writing format is necessary. *Word counts will be given in a final creative brief*
